

**Notice of Public Meeting for Applications for Plan of Subdivision and Official Plan Amendment & Zoning By-law Amendment (File Nos. S3/18 & OP23/18)**

Take Notice that the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville is in receipt of complete applications for a proposed Plan of Subdivision and Official Plan Amendment & Zoning By-law Amendment, pursuant to Section 51, Section 22 and Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, and that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville will hold a Public Meeting on

**Description of the Land:**  
The applications for Plan of Subdivision (S3/18) and Official Plan Amendment & Zoning By-law Amendment (OP23/18) affect lands legally described as West Part of Lot 1, Concession 3 (Reference Plan 76-5477) and are municipally known as S5 Broadway.

The subject lands affected by the proposal are located on the north side of Broadway, east of Veterans' Way (County Road No. 16) and south of the Orangeville-Brampton Railway line and are comprised of a single irregularly-shaped parcel of approximately 3.05 hectares (30.04 acres) in total area and approximately 152.14 metres of lot frontage onto Broadway. A location map of the subject property is attached.

**Purpose and Effect of the Applications:**  
The purpose and effect of the Plan of Subdivision application is to create four separate Blocks to facilitate the future development of a six-storey, 161-unit retirement home and 18, two-storey townhouse dwellings on two separate Blocks. The remaining two Blocks are proposed for Open Space and Stormwater Management Facility uses.

The Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment propose to re-designate and rezone the property from Low Density Residential and Open Space Conservation to site-specific Medium Density Residential and Open Space Conservation designations and zoning to permit the development as proposed through specific regulations (including maximum permitted residential density, site-specific parking rate, interior side yard setbacks (to a townhouse Block), maximum permitted building height, and minimum required distance between the closer edge of the street curb and the garage face (townhouses)).

**Public Meeting:**  
All persons interested in the above applications are invited to attend the public meeting. Those persons who attend the public meeting will be given an opportunity to ask questions or to make a verbal submission to Council. Written comments, addressed to the Mayor and Members of Council, may also be submitted either before or at the meeting and will become a matter of public record.

**Important Information About Preserving Your Appeal Rights:**  
If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville in respect of the proposed plan of subdivision before the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of subdivision, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville in respect of the proposed plan of subdivision before the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of subdivision, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville before the official plan amendment is adopted or before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville before the official plan amendment is adopted or before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
