## Fireworks Safety

If you choose to have family fireworks, here are some things to remember:

- Review the Town of Orangeville Fireworks By-law - Check it out online.
- Appoint a responsible person to be in charge. Only adults who are aware of the hazards and safety precautions should handle and discharge fireworks.
- Carefully read and follow the manufacturer's labeled directions on fireworks packaging.
- Always keep a water hose or pail of water close by when discharging fireworks.
- Discharge fireworks well away from combustible materials like buildings, trees and dry grass.
- Keep onlookers a safe distance away upwind from the area when fireworks are discharged.
- Light only one firework at a time and only when they are on the ground. Never try to light a firework in your hand or try to light dud fireworks. For dud fireworks, it is best to wait 30 minutes and soak them in a bucket of water and dispose in a metal container.
- Keep sparklers away from children. Sparklers burn extremely hot and can cause clothing and result in severe burns. As the sparkler waxes remain hot after burnout, place them in water to avoid injury.
- Be a good neighbour and always consider the safety and well-being of your neighbours as you celebrate.

To minimize the risk of fire and/or injury, the fire service does not recommend the use of fireworks or consumer neighbourhood displays.

### Junior Help Desk Student

The Town has a student job opportunity available, for the position of Junior Help Desk Student. This position is a six (6) month contract, anticipated to begin as soon as possible. Current post-secondary students, as well as recent post-secondary graduates, are both eligible to apply.

The Junior Help Desk Student will offer support and technical assistance to internal customers who use software, hardware, or other computer systems and need help completing tasks or troubleshooting problems through diagnostic tests and remote access to their computers.

**Job Duties:**

- Responding to queries via chat, email, or phone;
- acting as the first point of contact for customers seeking technical assistance, writing, editing, and revising training manuals for new and updated software and hardware; providing technical assistance for questions and problems, diagnosing system errors and other issues; and following up with customers to ensure full resolution of issues;
- Installing or changing software to fix issues; remotely accessing hardware or software for clients to make changes and fix problems; resolving problems with networks and other computer systems; and assisting users in security awareness, training for mobile, workstation and online accounts.
- Helping manage end user accounts for subscription systems; maintaining software and hardware assets through internal systems; remediating systems affected as required; and escalating to second tier support internally or externally to find solutions.

**Qualifications:**

- Candidates must be working towards, or have recently completed, a diploma or degree in Information Technology or a related course of study;
- Strong knowledge of Microsoft Client Operating Systems (Windows 10, 11);
- Microsoft Office skills, knowledge of mobile devices, PC hardware skills, and familiarity with both PC and Mac hardware and software.

## Orangeville VOTES Election Workers

The Town of Orangeville is seeking election workers to facilitate voting in the 2022 Municipal Election.

**Applicants must be:**

- 18+ to work in Canada
- Available to attend a training session scheduled between September 19 and 26, 2022.
- Available to work extended hours on Election Day - Monday October 24, 2022.

Remuneration for these positions range from \$125 - \$400 for Advance Voting Days and Election Day. In addition to performing assigned positions, Election Officials will be required to attend 1 training session (the week of September 19 or September 26, 2022), which will be 2-3 hours in length depending on the position.
